LADY'S CARDIGAN

TO FIT 32"-34" (36"-38") (40"-42") BUST

Correct results can only be obtained by using

BACK

Using No. 10 Needles, cast on 84 (96) (108) sts.

1st row. K2, * P1, K1, rep. from * to end of row.

Rep. 1st row 19 times.

Using No. 8 Needles, proceed as foll:—

For 32-34 in. bust only.

1st row. K1, * P3, KB., K2, KF., P1, rep. from * to last 3 sts., P2, K1.

2nd row. K4, * P2, K2, P2, K4, rep. from * to end.

These 2 rows from the patt.

For the 36-38 in. bust only.

1st row. K1, P4, * KB., K2, KF., P4, rep. from * to last st., K1.

2nd row. K5, * P2, K2, P2, K4, rep. from * to last st., K1.

These 2 rows form the pattern.

For the 40-42 in. bust only.

1st row. K2, * P4, KB., K2, KF., rep. from * to last 6 sts., P4, K2.

2nd row. K1, P1, * K4, P2, K2, P2, rep. from * to last 6 sts., K4, P1, K1.

These 2 rows form the patt.

All sizes.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows twice.

Con. in patt. inc. once at each end of next and every foll. 8th row (keeping extra sts. in patt.) until there are 98 (110) (122) sts. on the needle, ending on wrong side.

Con. in patt. inc. at each end of next and every foll. alt. row until there are 106 (120) (138) sts. on the needle, ending on wrong side.

Cast on 9 sts. at end of every row until there are 178 (192) (210) sts. on the needle.

Cast on 9 (8) (6) sts. at end of every row until there are 214 (224) (234) sts. on the needle.

Work 36 (40) (48) rows in patt. without further shaping.

Shape top of sleeves and shoulders.

Cast off 8 (7) (7) sts. at beg. of every row until 86 (112) (108) sts. rem.

Cast off 11 (11) (13) sts. at beg. of next 4 (6) (4) rows.

Cast off 11 (11) (14) sts. at beg. of next 2 (2) (2) rows.

Cast off rem. 20 (24) (28) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using No. 10 Needles, cast on 56 (64) (72) sts.

1st row. K2, * P1, K1, rep. from * to end.

Rep. 1st row 3 times.

5th row. K2, P1, K1, P1, cast off 4 sts., rib to end.

6th row. Rib to end, casting on 4 sts. in place of those cast off.

Rep. 1st row 14 times. Slip the first 14 sts. on to a thread.

Using No. 8 Needles, proceed as foll:—

For the 32-34 in. bust only.

1st row. K1, * P1, KB., K2, KF., P3, rep. from * to last st., K1.

2nd row. * K4, P2, K2, P2, rep. from * to last 2 sts., K2.

These 2 rows form the patt.

For the 36-38 in. bust only.

1st row. K3, KF., P4, * KB., K2, KF., P4, rep. from * to last st., K1.

2nd row. K5, * P2, K2, P2, K4, rep. from * to last 5 sts., P2, K3.

These 2 rows form the patt.

For the 40-42 in. bust only.

1st row. K2, * P4, KB., K2, KF., rep. from * to last 6 sts., P4, K2.

2nd row. K1, P1, * K4, P2, K2, P2, rep. from * to last 6 sts., K4, P1, K1.

These 2 rows form the patt.

All sizes.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows twice.

Con. in patt. inc. once at end of next and every foll. 8th row (keeping extra sts. in patt.), until there are 49 (57) (65) sts. on the needle, ending on wrong side.

Con. in patt. inc. at end of next and every foll.

ABBREVIATIONS

14, (16), (18) ozs. "LEE TARGET" MOTORAVIA Double-Knitting Wool.
Two No. 10 and Two No. 8 "MILWARDS DISC" Knitting Needles.
5 Buttons.

To fit 32-34 (36-38) (40-42) inch bust.

Length: 19 (20, 21,) ins.

6 sts. to one inch (pressed).

Success depends on working to correct tension.

K, knit; P, purl; inc., increase(ing); dec., decrease(ing); tog., together; st., stitch(es); rep., repeat; alt., alternate; ins., inches; beg., beginning; patt., pattern; K.B., knit into back of 2nd st. on left hand needle, then into front of 1st st., slipping both sts. off the needle together; K.F., knit into front of 2nd st. on left hand needle, then into front of 1st st., slipping both sts. off the needle together; con., continue; foll., following; rem., remaining.

N.B.—Follow first figures for 32-34 in. bust.

Follow first figures in brackets for 36-38 in. bust.

Follow second figures in brackets for 40-42 in. bust.

alt. row until there are 53 (62) (73) sts. on the needle, ending on wrong side.

Cast on 9 sts. at end of next and every foll. alt. row until there are 89 (98) (109) sts. on the needle, ending on wrong side.

Cast on 9 (8) (6) sts. on next and every foll. alt. row until there are 107 (114) (121) sts. on the needle, ending on wrong side.

Shape Neck.

Con. in patt. dec. once at neck edge only on the next and every foll. 4th row until 97 (103) (108) sts. rem.

Shape Top of sleeve and shoulder.

Still con. to dec. as before on every 4th row at neck edge for the 36-38 (40-42) in. bust only, until 14 (18) dec. have been worked in all, cast off 8 (7) (7) sts. at beg. of next and foll. 7 (7) (8) rows.

Cast off 11 (11) (13) sts. at beg. of next 2 (3) (2) alt. rows.

Cast off 11 (11) (14) sts. at beg. of next alt. row.

LEFT FRONT

Using No. 10 Needles, cast on 56 (64) (72) sts.

1st row. * K1, P1, rep. from * to last 2 sts, K2. Rep. 1st row 18 times.

20th row. (K1, P1) 7 times, slip these 14 sts. on to a thread, rib to end.

Using No. 8 Needles, proceed as foll:—

For the 32-34 in. bust only.

1st row. K1, * P3, KB., K2, KF., P1, rep. from * to last st., K1.

2nd row. K2, * P2, K2, P2, K4, rep. from * to end.

These 2 rows form the patt.

For the 36-38 in. bust only.

1st row. K1, * P4, KB., K2, KF., rep. from * to last 9 sts., P4, KB., K3.

2nd row. K3, P2, * K4, P2, K2, P2, rep. from * to last 5 sts., K5.

These 2 rows form the patt.

For the 40-42 in. bust only.

1st row. K2, * P4, KB., K2, KF., rep. from * to last 6 sts., P4, K2.

2nd row. K1, P1, * K4, P2, K2, P2, rep. from * to last 6 sts., K4, P1, K1.

All sizes.

Work as given for Right Front, reversing all shapings.

Sew up shoulder seams.

SLEEVE BANDS

Using No. 10 Needles with right side of work facing, pick up and knit 54 (58) (62) sts. evenly along sleeve edge.

1st row. K2, * P1, K1, rep. from * to end. Rep. 1st row 21 times. Cast off loosely in rib.

RIGHT FRONT BAND

Using No. 10 Needles rejoin wool to 14 sts. left on a thread on Right Front and work in rib, making buttonholes as before at intervals of 3 ins. until 5 buttonholes in all have been worked. Con. in rib until band is of sufficient length to go up the Front to centre of back neck. Cast off in rib.

LEFT FRONT BAND

Using No. 10 Needles, rejoin wool to 14 sts. left on a thread on Left Front. Work as given for Right Front Band, omitting buttonholes.

TO MAKE UP

Using a damp cloth and hot iron, press carefully. Sew up side and sleeve seams. Join front bands tog. and sew in position up each front and across back of neck placing the top buttonhole 2 rows below first front dec. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes. Press all seams.
